**TOPIC: SENTENCES** 

## **Explanation:**

A sentence is a group of words that are put together to mean something. A sentence is the basic unit of language which expresses a complete thought.

**TYPES OF SENTENCES:** 

- A **declarative sentence**, or decl ration, is the most common type of sentence. It tells something. It ends with a <u>full stop</u>. (*The dog is happy*.)
- An **interrogative sentence**, or question, asks something. It ends with a <u>question mark</u> ? (*Are you happy*?)
- An **exclamatory sentence**, or exclamation, says something out of the ordinary. It ends with an <u>exclamation mark</u>! (*That dog is the happiest dog I have ever seen!*)

• An **imperative sentence**, or command, tells someone to do something. (*Give the dog a bone*.)
