#### Food

The component that we consume, which provides nourishment to the body, is called food.


E.g., Rice, chapati, curry, fruits, vegetables, cheese, bread, milk, curd, butter, etc.

## Ingredients

The components or materials required to prepare a food item are called as ingredients.

E.g., different types of vegetables, spices are ingredients for sambar.

## Food Materials and Sources



## • Edible parts of plants

The parts of plant which are eaten are called edible parts

Roots: beets, carrots, radishes, turnips, ginger,

Stems: broccoli stem, bamboo shoots, sugar cane, potato

Leaves: spinach, lettuce etc.

Fruits: apple, pear, tomatoes, grapes, cherries, oranges

Edible Flowers: broccoli heads, cauliflower heads

Seeds: sunflower seeds

### Food Habits

The method of eating or choices of food followed by living organisms is called as food habit.

E.g. a rabbit eats grass or plant-based food.

#### Herbivores

Animals which **feed on plants** are called herbivores.

E.g., cow, goat etc.

#### Carnivores

Animals which feed on other animals are called carnivores.

E.g., lion, tiger etc

# Omnivores

Animals which **feed on both** plants and other animals are called omnivores.

E.g., bears. They feed on flesh as well as honey

# Scavengers

The animals that eat flesh of dead animals. They help in cleaning the environment. Scavengers have an important role to play in the food chain. They keep an ecosystem free of the bodies of dead animals and their decaying flesh. Scavengers break down this organic material and recycle it into the ecosystem as nutrients. For Example Vultures who are scavengers, only eat the bodies of dead animals.

#### Parasites

Small animals that depend on other animals(host) for their food are called parasites.eg. Leech, mosquito, etc.
