

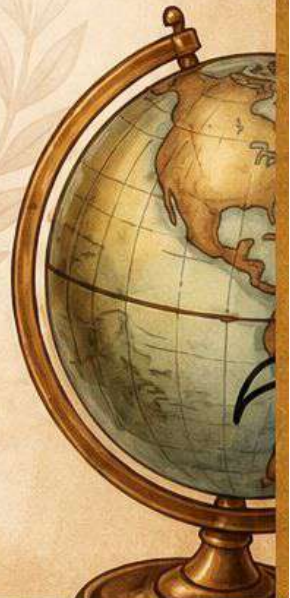

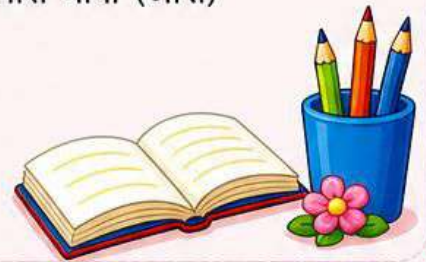

Joy Ride



- ★ **Social Skills:** Sharing ideas, role play, communication
- ★ **Fine Motor Skills:** Drawing, coloring, detailing characters
- ★ **Gross Motor Skills:** Minimal (if dramatization is added, then body movement)
- ★ **Cognitive Skills:** Creativity, imagination, understanding instructions



Leaf Collection



- ★ **Social Skills:** Teamwork (if done in groups), discussion about nature
- ★ **Fine Motor Skills:** Picking leaves, pasting, arranging neatly
- ★ **Gross Motor Skills:** Walking, collecting materials outdoors
- ★ **Cognitive Skills:** Observation, classification, knowledge of nature



Shop 'Til You Drop



- ★ **Social Skills:** Communication, role play (buyer/seller), cooperation
- ★ **Fine Motor Skills:** Handling play money, writing labels
- ★ **Gross Motor Skills:** Movement during activity setup (optional)
- ★ **Cognitive Skills:** Basic math (addition/subtraction), problem-solving, decision-making



Roots and wings



- ★ **Social Skills:** Understanding relationships, emotional bonding
- ★ **Fine Motor Skills:** Drawing, writing names, decorating
- ★ **Gross Motor Skills:** Minimal
- ★ **Cognitive Skills:** Memory recall, sequencing (family hierarchy), self-awareness



Project on Houses



- ★ **Social Skills:** Presentation skills, sharing ideas
- ★ **Fine Motor Skills:** Cutting, pasting, drawing structures
- ★ **Gross Motor Skills:** Minimal
- ★ **Cognitive Skills:** Classification, understanding types of houses, environmental awareness



Computer Uses



- ★ **Social Skills:** Awareness of technology in society
- ★ **Fine Motor Skills:** Basic handling (if practical exposure is given)
- ★ **Gross Motor Skills:** Minimal
- ★ **Cognitive Skills:** Understanding applications of computers, real-life connections, reasoning

Shelf
